| 2. | Go approximately 4½ blocks to the Old Catholic High School, the large white building which will be on the right. You will pass the Holy Rosary Parish, which was on the left, one block before the old Catholic High School. |
| 3. | The parking is on the right side of the building. |
| 4. | Use the basement entrance at the front of the building, the meeting is in the hall beyond the kitchen. |

| Driving | Driving from the Seattle area to Pomeroy is about a 5 hour drive: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Follow I-90 E to WA-26 E in Grant County.• Take exit 137 from I-90 E• Continue on WA-26 E to Columbia County• Drive to US-12 E in Pomeroy |
| Flying | A limited number of daily flights connect Seattle-Tacoma International Airport to destinations serving SE Washington: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Lewiston, ID - There are currently no direct flights from Seattle• Pullman, WA - Alaska Air offers 2 nonstop flights daily and American Airlines offers 1 nonstop daily• Walla Walla, WA – Alaska Air and American Airlines each offer 1 non-stop flight daily Flying into these airports would require driving 25-40 miles to reach Pomeroy. |
| Lodging | Some overnight accommodations are available in Pomeroy, such as B&Bs like Maggie's Garden and The Ridge House. Additional lodging is available in Clarkston, Dayton, Waitsburg, and Walla Walla, WA or in Lewiston, ID. Please check with the lodging directly for availability. |
| Lunch | On the day of the meeting, a simple box lunch will be provided at no cost. Due to the time required for a site tour, it is anticipated that Bidders' Conference attendees will take a lunch box in their vehicle while the group caravans to the first stop. The lunch box will include a water bottle and a sports drink. |
