Scheduled power outage Sunday, Sept. 13, 2009, 2 - 5 a.m.

Dear Resident or Business Owner,

Puget Sound Energy is working to upgrade our electric system from our existing low-voltage 55 kilovolt (kV) transmission line to our now current standard of 115 kV in the Enumclaw, Buckley and Wilkeson areas to increase reliability of the electric system and to meet additional demand. As part of this effort, PSE will be taking the Wilkeson substation, located at 213 Church St. in Wilkeson, offline early Sunday morning, Sept. 13. The work will be performed by Potelco, a PSE subcontractor.

We are writing to provide you with notice and to ask for your patience while we make these improvements. This is the second of three scheduled outages for this project. **Most importantly, we want to notify you that the project will require us to shut off the power to our customers between 2 and 5 a.m. on Sunday, Sept. 13, to safely complete this work.** Affected areas include the communities of Wilkeson and Carbonado and surrounding areas outlined on the map on the backside of this letter.

We appreciate your understanding the need for this temporary disruption of your electric service while we upgrade our electric system.
