

**You may already know that Puget Sound Energy (PSE) offers an array of energy efficiency programs to our customers to help offset the need for new energy resources.** However, what you may not know is that the WUTC (Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission) closely monitors the energy savings goals and associated costs for PSE's energy efficiency programs.

During the last two years (2004 and 2005), PSE was required to meet a certain threshold of cost effective energy savings through these programs. If these goals were not met, PSE could have incurred a financial penalty of up to \$1.5M.

## Results



**We are pleased to present to you our energy efficiency program performance results. During 2004 and 2005, PSE's energy efficiency programs:**

- Exceeded all energy savings goals within the required time frame and did so under budget.
- Exceeded the 39.16 aMW (electric) savings goal by achieving 39.34 aMW of savings (equivalent to the amount of electricity used to power 28,718 homes over one year).
- Exceeded the 5,013,480 therm (natural gas) savings goal by achieving 6,072,348 therms of savings (equivalent to the amount of natural gas used to heat 6,325 homes over one year).
