

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Upgrading your neighborhood

October 23, 2007



Dear Resident or Business Owner,

Puget Sound Energy is working to upgrade our electric system in the Chimacum area to meet customers' current and future needs. We have received all the necessary permits to build a new distribution substation this fall at the location shown on the map.

We have already cleared and graded the site. Beginning the week of October 29, our contractor will begin the construction of the transmission lines, which will run from the substation along Chimacum Road to the intersection of State Route 19 and Chimacum Road. The work will take place **Mondays through Fridays between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m.** Portions of the work at the intersection of State Route 19 and Chimacum Road will take place at night. When needed, signs and flaggers will help direct traffic.



Location of Chimacum Substation

This portion of the project includes installation of the transmission line poles and undergrounding of the existing distribution lines that run along Chimacum Road. The work may cause disruption in your electric service. If the work requires a scheduled power outage, we will provide notice prior to the outage.

Construction is expected to be complete by the end of November.
