**SCHEDULE 135
GREEN ENERGY OPTION - PURCHASE RIDER**

AVAILABILITY:

- 1. Service under this schedule is available to all Customers as an option designed to provide Customers an opportunity to purchase qualified alternative energy resources. Service is on a continuing month to month basis unless terminated as provided herein. (N)

- 2. Participating Customers will support the use and development of alternative energy resources or "green energy" resources which are generation facilities fueled by energy sources which include wind; solar energy; geothermal energy; landfill gas; wave or tidal action; gas produced during the treatment of wastewater; qualified hydropower; or biomass energy based on animal waste or solid organic fuels from wood, forest, or field residues or dedicated energy crops that do not include wood pieces that have been treated with chemical preservatives such as creosote, pentachlorophenol, or copper-chrome-arsenic. TYPE OF SERVICE:

Service under this schedule is provided through Renewable Energy Credits ("Credits") obtained by the Company. These Credits will be provided through either: (a) Resources the Company owns or contracts for; or (b) the purchase of Credits issued by a clearinghouse or other system, provided the Company is able to secure verifiable evidence that there is a qualified alternative energy resource available and that the green energy attribute of the alternative energy resource will be available to the Company for purchase by its Customers.

MONTHLY RATE:

Customers may purchase an unlimited number of blocks of green energy at \$2.00 each. A block is equivalent to a 160 kWh purchase. The minimum monthly purchase is two blocks per month. Under this option the monthly charge for green energy will be the same every month. (C)

OR

Customers may purchase green energy that is equal to 100% of their total monthly energy usage at a rate of \$0.0125 per kWh. Under this option the monthly charge for green energy will vary based on energy usage. (R)

The monthly charge in this rider is in addition to all other charges contained in the rate schedule under which the Customer receives service. The monthly charge for blocks of green energy under this rider will be applied to the Customer's billing regardless of actual energy usage.

ENROLLMENT:

Customers are required to complete the Company's enrollment process to participate in this program. Initiation of service under this rider will occur following acceptance and processing of the enrollment request by the Company. The Company may remove Customers from the rider or refuse to enroll Customers who have not paid the green power portion of their bill.

The Company will attempt to transfer a Customer's green energy choice and continue billing for green energy when a Customer moves within the Company's electric service territory, however, a Customer may discontinue service under this schedule at any time in accordance with the "Termination By Customer" paragraph below. TERMINATION BY CUSTOMER:

Customers are required to notify the Company prior to their desired termination date in the program. Termination of service under this rider will follow receipt and processing of the termination request by the Company. Customers who close their account will be billed a pro-rated amount based on the termination date.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:

1. The Company may limit Customer participation in this rider to balance Customer demand with available credits acquired from qualified alternative energy resources by the Company.
2. The Company shall forecast and plan purchases of green power credits to meet projected quantities purchased on an annual basis. (C)
3. The Company makes no guarantee of any kind that this program will result in the development of any amount of alternative energy resources.

DEFINITIONS:

"Renewable Energy Credits", also know as green tags, renewable energy certificates, or tradeable renewable certificates, represent the environmental attributes of electric energy generated from renewable, qualified alternative energy resources as described in Section 2 of AVAILABILITY above. (N)

ADJUSTMENTS:

Rates in this schedule are subject to adjustment by such other schedules in this tariff as may apply.

GENERAL RULES AND PROVISIONS:

Service under this schedule is subject to the General Rules and Provisions contained in this tariff.
