Must I really call 811 before digging?

If you're using your front paws, no. But in most other circumstances, the law requires you to call 811 before digging so you don't hurt yourself or damage pipes or wires. Make the call two full business days before you plan to dig. (The day you call doesn't count.) Outline your dig area in white paint so that the utilities will know where to mark. Even homeowners digging on their own property must call, if digging deeper than 12 inches. So don't take a chance. Call 811 before you dig, then dig with paws hand tools within 2 feet of the markings.
