April is Safe Digging Month, a good time to remember to call 811 two business days before beginning any work that involves digging. PSE will have its underground natural gas and electric lines marked so you can avoid injury or damage from accidentally striking them. Washington state law requires all digging projects on private, public and commercial property to have utilities marked.
