

## Northeast Spring Boulevard-area utility relocation project

July 19, 2017

In preparation for construction of Sound Transit's upcoming East Link Extension light rail project, and to ensure we continue to deliver safe and reliable energy to you and your neighbors, Puget Sound Energy will be undergrounding sections of the existing above-ground electrical infrastructure as well as relocating select utility poles and related electrical equipment along 130<sup>th</sup> Avenue Northeast, Northeast Spring Boulevard and 136<sup>th</sup> Place Northeast.

We are committed to completing our work safely and efficiently, and our crews will do their best to reduce impacts to nearby neighbors. However, there may be some noise and temporary traffic disruptions in the project area. Additionally, <u>some</u> customers may experience a brief, planned power outage as a result of this work. Please see below for project details.

#### **Project details**

- Who: Electric crews from PSE and Potelco
- **What:** Undergrounding sections of the existing above-ground electrical infrastructure, relocating select utility poles and related electrical equipment
- **Where:** Portions of 130<sup>th</sup> Avenue Northeast, Northeast Spring Boulevard and 136<sup>th</sup> Place Northeast (please see map on reverse for route details)
- When: Beginning the week of July 24 and lasting approximately five months
  - Typical work hours are Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. • Weekend work tentatively scheduled for late August/early September at the
  - intersection of Northeast 20th Street and 136th Place Northeast
  - Work schedule is weather dependent

### What you can expect

- Reduced travel lanes and temporary parking restrictions
- There will likely be noise from trucks and heavy machinery
- Traffic control signs and personnel will guide vehicles and pedestrians safely through the work zone
- Some customers may experience a brief, planned power outage. All impacted customers will be notified directly in advance of any planned outages
