Lake Shannon day use park project

This letter is to inform the Concrete community of an upcoming project anticipated to begin within the first week of April 2021. Puget Sound Energy (PSE) is constructing a public day use park at the current Lake Shannon boat launch site. The new park will provide parking, restrooms and a picnic shelter for the public to enjoy starting in the fall of 2021. This project helps PSE meet Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) requirements as part of the licensing agreement for the Baker Hydroelectric project. We're committed to completing our work safely and efficiently, and our crews and contractors will do their best to reduce construction impacts to the community.

Project details

- Who:** PSE crews and Faber Construction contractors
- What:** Constructing a day use park at the Lake Shannon boat launch site
- When:** Expected to begin in April and last up to approximately five (5) months
- Work hours are typically Monday – Thursday, 7:30 a.m. – 5 p.m.
- Where:** Lake Shannon Road, Concrete (see map)

What you can expect

- Noise from trucks and heavy machinery
- The boat launch will remain open throughout construction with periodic restrictions to public access. Boat launch access restrictions will be communicated in advance via posted signage and the Baker webpage.

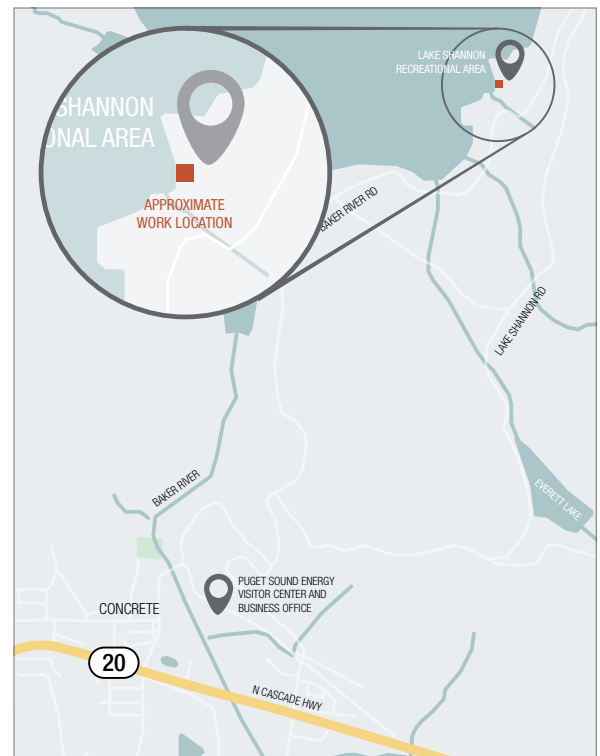
