



Early warning siren testing at Baker River Hydroelectric Project

In an effort to ensure continued public safety and reliability, Puget Sound Energy will be testing its early-warning siren system at the Baker River Hydroelectric Project. The purpose of this test is to conduct siren and operational assessments as a follow up to the early-warning siren system that was installed in 2018.

What you can expect:

During the sound testing, the sirens will produce a tone and two verbal messages. This is a scheduled test and only a test of the siren system. When the sirens sound during this timeframe, residents are *not* called to evacuate.

When: July 18, 2023 between 11 a.m. and 3 p.m.

Where: The sirens to be tested are located in and around the town of Concrete, including Van Horn, Grassmere, Cape Horn, and Birdsvew
