#### Local engagement

Each year your local PSE community teams reach out to residential, commercial and industrial customers as well as government agencies. The goal of this outreach is to exchange information on major projects, ways to conserve energy and renewable energy options. We also partner with organizations that strengthen the fabric of our communities such as downtown associations, chambers of commerce, non-profits and foodbanks. In 2022, highlights include a \$16,000 grant that we provided to the Issaquah salmon hatchery, and a \$25,000 grant that we provided to Healthpoint.

We are proud to participate in local events such as Issaguah Salmon Days and the Woodinville Festival. In addition, we make dozens of presentations to organizations ranging from staff meetings, city councils, and home owner associations.

#### Community investments and **Powerful Partnerships**

Puget Sound Energy and PSE Foundation gave over \$3.2M to community-based organizations in 2022. These contributions help provide essential needs and services to PSE's customers and communities at large. PSE and PSEF invested over **\$1.3 million** in King County.
