

## East Portland Avenue area natural gas main realignment

May 2018

In conjunction with the WSDOT I-5 M Street to Portland Avenue – HOV work, Puget Sound Energy will be relocating the existing natural gas main away from the L Street Bridge – which WSDOT will be demolishing – and realigning the natural gas main to make way for WSDOT's work. We're committed to completing the work safely and efficiently, and our crews will do their best to reduce impacts to nearby neighbors. Please see below for project details.

## **Project Details**

Who: Natural gas crews from PSE and InfraSource

What: Realigning a section of existing underground natural gas pipe

When: Beginning in May and expected to last through July (see map on reverse for location and timing)

- Work along Portland Avenue E will typically occur Monday through Saturday, overnight from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Work along the other streets will typically occur Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. and possibly Saturday from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m.

## What you can expect

- Prior to work beginning, our tree trimming partner, Asplundh, will trim brush along the right-of-way up the E 31st Street hill between East M and East N Streets
- Signs and traffic control flaggers will guide vehicles safely through the work zone
- There will likely be noise from trucks and heavy machinery
- Signs will be posted to designate parking restrictions along the route
- This work should not impact electric or natural gas service for customers
