Construction set to begin as early as September on Glacier battery storage project

Work to install a state-of-the-art battery storage system adjacent to Puget Sound Energy's Glacier substation will begin as early as this September. We will do our best to reduce impacts to the community and appreciate your patience as we work to complete the project.

- Who:** Crews from PSE, Potelco, RES Americas, 1Energy, and their subcontractors
- What:** Tree removal on PSE's substation property, installing new fencing, updating substation equipment, installing four battery containers and associated equipment required to connect the battery system to the electric grid. Crews will use trucks and large equipment to complete the work; flaggers will direct traffic when working in the roadway; however, we anticipate limited construction on State Route 542.
- When:** Sept. 1, 2015 until June 1, 2016 (est.)
Mondays through Saturdays, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.
- Where:** Glacier Substation on Vaughn Ave.
