

Upcoming PSE night work



Wallingford-area natural gas project update

May 17, 2019

Dear neighbor,

This update is regarding a Puget Sound Energy natural gas project currently under construction in your neighborhood, and we're reaching out to notify you about a change in the construction schedule to include night work.

PSE and Infracource are working to replace the existing natural gas main, with a larger, corrosion-resistant plastic main, as well as replacing individual service lines to some homes and businesses. Crews are starting to work toward the intersection of Green Lake Way N, Stone Way N, and N 50th St. In order to cross this arterial road, and to reduce impacts to you and your neighbors, **this portion of the work will be completed at night**. Please see project details below.

Project details

- Who:** Natural gas crews from PSE and Infracource
What: Replacing the underground natural gas main and some individual service lines
When: Expected to begin May 28, 2019 and last for approximately two (2) weeks
- o Work hours: Sunday night through Friday morning 7 p.m. – 6 a.m.
 - o Crews will abide by all city noise ordinance laws
- Where:** Green Lake Way N, Stone Way N, and N 50th St, Seattle

What you can expect

- Signs and traffic control flaggers will guide vehicles and pedestrians safely through the work zone.
- Lane closures and possible traffic delays through the area.
- Typical construction noise from trucks and heavy machinery.
