## Improving the power system for our customers

Starting in late August, PSE will begin rebuilding the existing transmission and distribution lines between Alger and Belfast. Rebuilding the transmission and distribution lines with new, higher capacity wire will strengthen the current system and improve electric reliability for our customers in the area.

What you can expect:

- What: Work includes upgrading approximately 4 miles of an existing 115 kV transmission line by replacing the existing structures with new wood poles and new 115 kV conductors (wires), as well as replacing approximately 3 miles of an existing single-phase distribution line with three-phase tree wire. Tree wire is a specially-coated wire that significantly reduces the frequency of tree-related outages.
- Where: The existing transmission corridor, running cross-country from the intersection of Routon Ln and Old Hwy 99 N near Alger to Prairie Rd near Old Hwy 99 N in Belfast. A detailed map is available at **pse.com/algertd**.
- Who: PSE and our contractor crews.
- When: Mondays Fridays, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., late August through October. Some work on Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. may be required.
