

Electric space heat rebates

General qualifications

- You must be a current PSE single-family¹ residential electric customer. Single-family new construction, multifamily (five or more attached units) and commercial accounts are not eligible.
- Equipment installed in manufactured homes must apply on a different rebate application. Please visit pse.com/rebates/manufactured-homes.
- Customers with existing natural gas forced air furnaces or natural gas boilers are not eligible for heat pump conversion rebates.
- Rebate application must be submitted within 30 days of purchase.
- Rebates only available on new, qualifying equipment.
- Equipment that is replaced under warranty will not be eligible for second rebate.
- One rebate per qualified single-family residence.
- Cannot be combined with any other rebates except where noted.
- Must install to comply with all federal, state and local code requirements.
- Rebate cannot exceed the pre-tax purchase price of any rebated product.
- Homes or accessory dwelling units (ADUs) with existing heat pumps are not eligible for a conversion rebate.
- For units that have both HSPF and HSPF2, the HSPF rating will be used to determine eligibility.

Electric forced-air furnace to ducted cold climate heat pump conversion:

- Your primary and current heating system must be electric forced-air to qualify.
- Your new heat pump system must have an HSPF of at least 9.5 or an HSPF2 of at least 8.1, COP at 5° F ≥ 1.75, and Percent of Heating Capacity at 5°F ≥ 70% of that at 47°F.
- Ductless heat pumps are not eligible.

Zonal electric resistance to ductless heat pump conversion

- Your primary and current heating system must be zonal electric resistance to qualify. This includes: baseboard, cable, wall heater, or electric hydronic systems.
- Your new ductless system must be AHRI Certified® as a mini-split heat pump, use inverter technology, and be a minimum of 3/4 ton in heating mode
- It must have an HSPF of at least 9.0 or an HSPF2 of at least 8.6.
- At least one indoor head must be installed in the main living area of the home; bedroom only installations do not qualify.
- To qualify for a rebate, ADUs must be occupied full time, must be an additional living area independent of the primary dwelling unit (with no venting from the primary dwelling) and must include a fully functioning kitchen and full bathroom.

Electric forced-air furnace to ductless heat pump conversion

- Your primary and current space heating system must be an electric forced-air furnace.
- Your new ductless heat pump system must be AHRI Certified® as a variable speed mini-split and multi-split heat pump, use inverter technology, and be a minimum of ¾ ton in heating mode.
- It must have an HSPF of at least 9.0 or an HSPF2 of at least 8.6. At least one indoor head must be installed in the main living area of the home; bedroom only installations do not qualify.

Electric forced-air furnace to air-source heat pump conversion

- Your primary and current heating system must be electric forced-air to qualify.
- Your new traditional heat pump system must be AHRI certified with an HSPF of at least 8.5 or HSPF2 of at least 7.5.
