

Manufactured homes space and water heat rebates

General qualifications

- You must be a current PSE manufactured or mobile home residential electric customer. New construction, multifamily (five or more attached units) and commercial accounts are not eligible.
- Qualifying electric equipment must be installed in PSE's electric service area.
- Rebate application must be submitted within 30 days of purchase. (Do-It-Yourself electric hybrid water heaters may have up to 60 days from date of purchase to apply.)
- Rebates only available on new, qualifying equipment.
- Equipment that is replaced under warranty will not be eligible for second rebate.
- One space heat rebate and one water heat rebate per qualified manufactured home residence.
- Cannot be combined with any other rebates except where noted.
- Must install to comply with all federal, state and local code requirements.
- Rebate cannot exceed the pre-tax purchase price of any rebated product.
- Cannot be combined with rebate price-matching discounts offered by retailers.
- Equipment installed in single family homes must apply on a different rebate application. Please visit [PSE.com/Rebates](https://www.pse.com/Rebates).
- Homes or ADU's with existing heat pumps are not eligible for a conversion rebate.
- For heat pump rebates, installation must be completed by a licensed contractor and in accordance with manufacturer guidelines. Self-installed equipment is not eligible for a rebate.

Manufactured home and mobile homes: factory built dwelling that includes: (a) plumbing, heating, air conditioning, and electrical systems, normally contained within the belly of the structure and within a rodent barrier; (b) is built on a permanent chassis; (c) can be transported in one or more sections; (d) may, or may not be permanently affixed to a concrete foundation.

Heat pump water heater – NEEA Tier 3/4

- Electric hybrid water heaters may also be eligible for additional retail or midstream incentives. Please visit [PSE.com/Instant](https://www.pse.com/Instant) for more information.
- Rebate amounts may be increased if purchased from neither a participating store nor from a contractor participating in PSE's Midstream Residential Water Heating program. Please contact PSE at 1-800-562-1482 to discuss rebate options if you purchased your equipment from an online or brick and mortar store that is not participating in PSE's Electric Hybrid Water Heater Program.
- Your electric hybrid water heater must run on electricity.
- Your electric hybrid water heater must meet NEEA Northern Climate Tier 3 or Tier 4 specifications. Visit [neea.org/resources/hpwh-qualified-products-list](https://www.neea.org/resources/hpwh-qualified-products-list) for a list of qualifying models.
- This rebate is not available when installed in conjunction with a geothermal heat pump.

Zonal electric resistance or electric forced air furnace to ductless heat pump conversion

- Your primary and current heating system must be zonal electric resistance to qualify. This includes: baseboard, electric forced air furnace, cable, wall heater, or electric hydronic systems.
- Customers with existing natural gas forced air furnaces or natural gas boilers are not eligible.
- Your new ductless system must be AHRI Certified® as a variable speed mini-split or multi-split heat pump, use inverter technology, and be a minimum of 3/4 ton in heating mode.
- It must meet or exceed the current national energy efficiency standard for residential heat pumps.
- With a ductless system, at least one indoor head must be installed in the main living area of the home; bedroom-only installations do not qualify.
- The heat pump may not make use of any ducted systems for conditioned air delivery.
- To qualify for a rebate, accessory dwelling units (ADU) must be occupied full time, must be an additional living area independent of the primary dwelling unit (with no venting from the primary dwelling) and must include a fully functioning kitchen and full bathroom.

Electric forced-air furnace to air-source heat pump conversion

- Your primary and current heating system must be electric forced-air to qualify.
- Customers with existing natural gas forced air furnaces or natural gas boilers are not eligible for heat pump conversion rebates.
- Your new ducted heat pump system must be AHRI certified.
- It must meet or exceed the current national energy efficiency standard for residential heat pumps.
- Compressor lock out must be disabled. If not possible, compressor lock out temperature must be set at or below the system balance point.
- Electric resistance backup heat must be locked out so it does not operate when the compressor can still meet the home's heating load efficiently (defrost cycles or compressor failure excluded).
 - Recommended lockout is at 5°F above balance point.
 - If locked out at more than 5°F above balance point, provide justification with rebate application.
- Guidance on thermostat programming must be provided to residents to prevent unnecessary use of backup or emergency heat.

Electric forced-air furnace to ductless heat pump conversion

- Your primary and current space heating system must be an electric forced-air furnace.
- Your new ductless system must be AHRI Certified® as a variable speed mini-split or multi-split heat pump, use inverter technology, and be a minimum of 3/4 ton in heating mode.
- It must meet or exceed the current national energy efficiency standard for residential heat pumps.
- At least one indoor head must be installed in the main living area of the home; bedroom-only installations do not qualify.
