Sustainability goals

As a Certified B Corporation, Aslan Brewing Company is committed to high social and environmental standards and is required to consider the impact of their decisions for their workers, suppliers, consumers, and the environment.

To pursue these goals, Aslan supports watershed restoration, utilizes green building techniques, and harvests rainwater to maintain an outdoor garden and minimize storm water runoff. Given their sustainability goals, opting into 100% renewable energy through PSE's Green Power was a no-brainer.
