Puget Sound Energy public comment for new investment

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Puget Sound Energy ("PSE") has asked the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("UTC") for authorization to transfer a non-controlling 31.6% ownership interest in PSE's parent company, Puget Holdings LLC, which is currently held by funds managed by Canada Pension Plan Investment Board to the following two purchasers: Macquarie Washington Clean Energy Investment L.P. ("Macquarie") and Ontario Teachers' Pension Plan Board ("Ontario Teachers"). This transfer is contingent upon approval by the UTC.

Puget Holdings' primary operating subsidiary, PSE, is the oldest and largest electric and natural gas utility in the State of Washington, serving approximately 1.2 million electric customers and 900,000 natural gas customers in the Puget Sound region. Ontario Teachers' administers Canada's largest single-profession pension plan. Macquarie is returning as an investor in PSE, after having previously led a consortium of investors through a time-limited fund that ended in 2019. PSE's other investors will maintain their current level of interest: Alberta Investment Management Corporation (13.6%); British Columbia Investment Management Corporation (20.9%); OMERS Administration Corporation (23.9%); and Stichting Depositary PGGM Infrastructure Funds (10%).
