

## Wild Horse Wind Facility recreation access rules

Violation of these rules will result in loss of all access privileges and possible enforcement action.

- 1. Access is allowed from April 1 to November 30, seven days per week from 2 hours before sunrise to 2 hours after sunset. Gate sensors allow exit from site 24 hours a day.
- 2. No access allowed from December 1 to March 31 or during other posted closure periods.
- 3. Access may be restricted at any time due to emergencies or operational issues.
- 4. No access of any kind within 300 feet (100 yards) of the wind turbines, solar panels, met towers, or microwave facilities.
- 5. Your recreation access permit must be clearly displayed on vehicle dash and visible from outside of vehicle while accessing the facility for all recreational activities.
- 6. Licensed vehicle traffic is permitted only on Beacon Ridge Road. Driving on other wind turbine access roads is not allowed.
- 7. Maximum speed limit is 25 mph unless otherwise posted. Wind maintenance service trucks, cranes, and heavy equipment have right-of-way.
- 8. No off-road driving permitted. Licensed off-road vehicles or licensed all-terrain vehicles (ATVs) are allowed on Beacon Ridge Road only.
- 9. Parking allowed only along Beacon Ridge Road and in designated parking areas as shown on the Recreation Access Map. Do not block access to gates, junction boxes, or any entrances.
- 10. No camping or overnight parking.
- 11. No target shooting.
- 12. No fires, open flames, fireworks or any other items or activities that may cause fires. Smoking is not allowed outside of vehicle.
- 13. No launching of balloons, aerial vehicles, drones or kites.
- 14. No commercial photography.
- 15. No consumption of alcohol, marijuana or any illegal drugs.
