## Electric/High Voltage

- Step and touch potential
- Working safely near power lines & downed wires
- Vegetation management
- Coordination of emergency response with PSE

## Natural Gas

Our natural gas training is approximately **90 minutes** and is led by an experienced gas first responder.

The training covers the following:

- Natural gas basics
- PSE's natural gas system
- Responding to natural gas incidents
- Multiple meter sets, valves, and other equipment
- Protecting yourself and others
- Natural gas system mockup demonstration
- Coordination of emergency response with PSE
- Q&A
