Natural gas main installation

PROJECT INFORMATION



Dear Neighbor,

Beginning Tuesday, Sept. 2, Puget Sound Energy's natural gas contractor, InfraSource, will install new intermediate pressure natural gas pipe along Seneca Street between Western Avenue and Alaskan Way. The work is being done in conjunction with the Seattle Waterfront Seawall Project. The pipeline extension will allow PSE to continue to provide natural gas service to waterfront customers during Seawall construction.

What you can expect*

- Work will begin Sept. 2 and last approximately three weeks from start.
- Construction will take place along Seneca St, beginning at Alaskan Way and progressing toward Western Ave (see map).
- Work activities will take place from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m., Mondays-Thursdays and from 11 p.m. to 8 a.m. on Fridays and Saturdays (as necessary). Noisy work (such as saw cutting) will take place between 7 a.m. and 10 a.m.
- Activities will include sawcutting, jack hammering and open trenching, as well as installation and testing of the new pipe.
- Restoration will include trench backfilling and roadway repaving (a PSE contractor will perform roadway restoration work).


**Work hours, schedule and construction activities may vary; some work activities may be weather dependent.*

Traffic impacts

- Traffic will be restricted along Seneca St during work hours.
- Signs and flaggers will be used to safely direct traffic around the work zone while construction is taking place.
- Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to use caution when traveling near the construction zone.
