
Mercer West natural gas main relocation PROJECT NOTICE ▶▶▶

Dear Resident or Business Owner,

Beginning as early as the week of Sept. 15, Puget Sound Energy (PSE) will begin work to relocate roughly 500 feet of 12-inch high pressure natural gas pipeline along Mercer St in conjunction with the Mercer West Corridor Project. Our natural gas service partner, InfraSource, will perform the work.

Work activities*

- Construction will take place on Mercer St between 6th Ave N and Dexter Ave N (see map).
- Noisy work activities will include jack hammering and excavating. Crews will use back-up mufflers and other devices to reduce noise from machinery. PSE will operate under and adhere to a noise variance issued by SDOT.
- Crews will install a new section of pipe and connect it to the existing system, then decommission the old pipe.
- Restoration will include trench back-filling.
- This work will take place within the existing construction zone and is not expected to impact traffic or pedestrians.



Work schedule*

- Work will begin as early as Sept. 15 and last approximately 4 weeks.
- Crews will complete the majority of work at night generally between 5 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- *Work hours, schedule and construction activities may vary; some work activities may be weather dependent.
