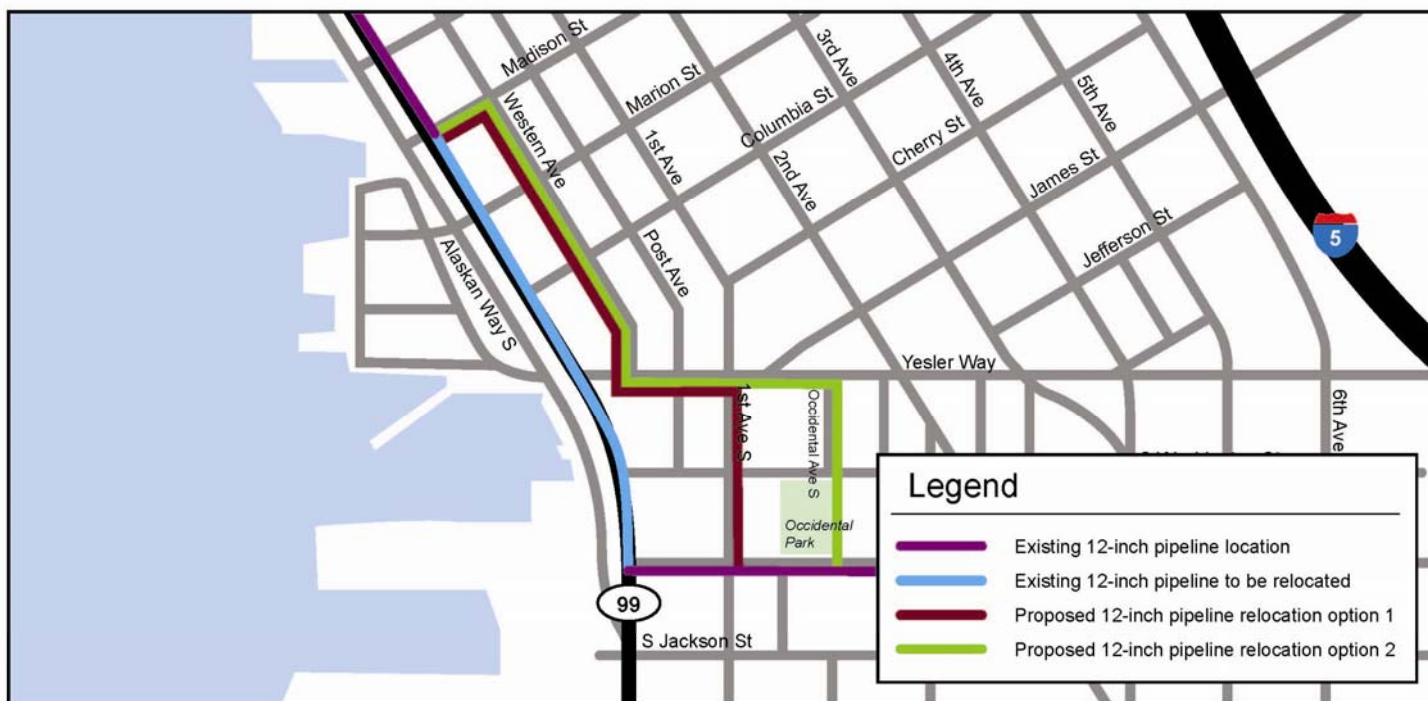

The Project

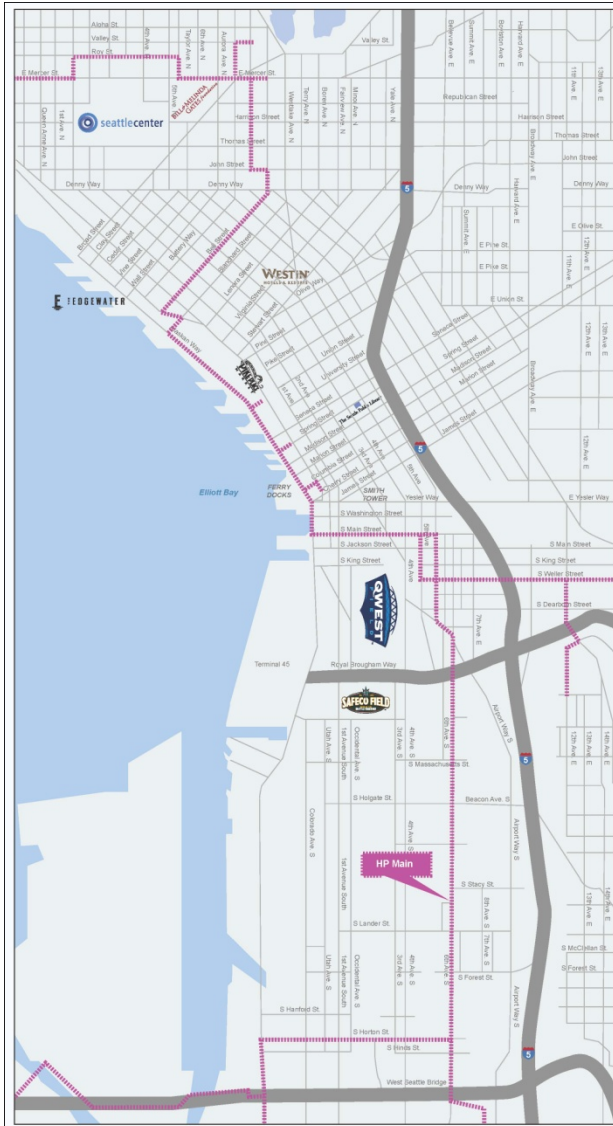
- Relocate a segment of existing high pressure natural gas pipeline from under the Viaduct

12-inch High Pressure Natural Gas Main Relocation



Critical natural gas supply



- 12-inch high pressure natural gas pipeline serves all Seattle-area natural gas customers
- It's the I-5 of natural gas pipelines

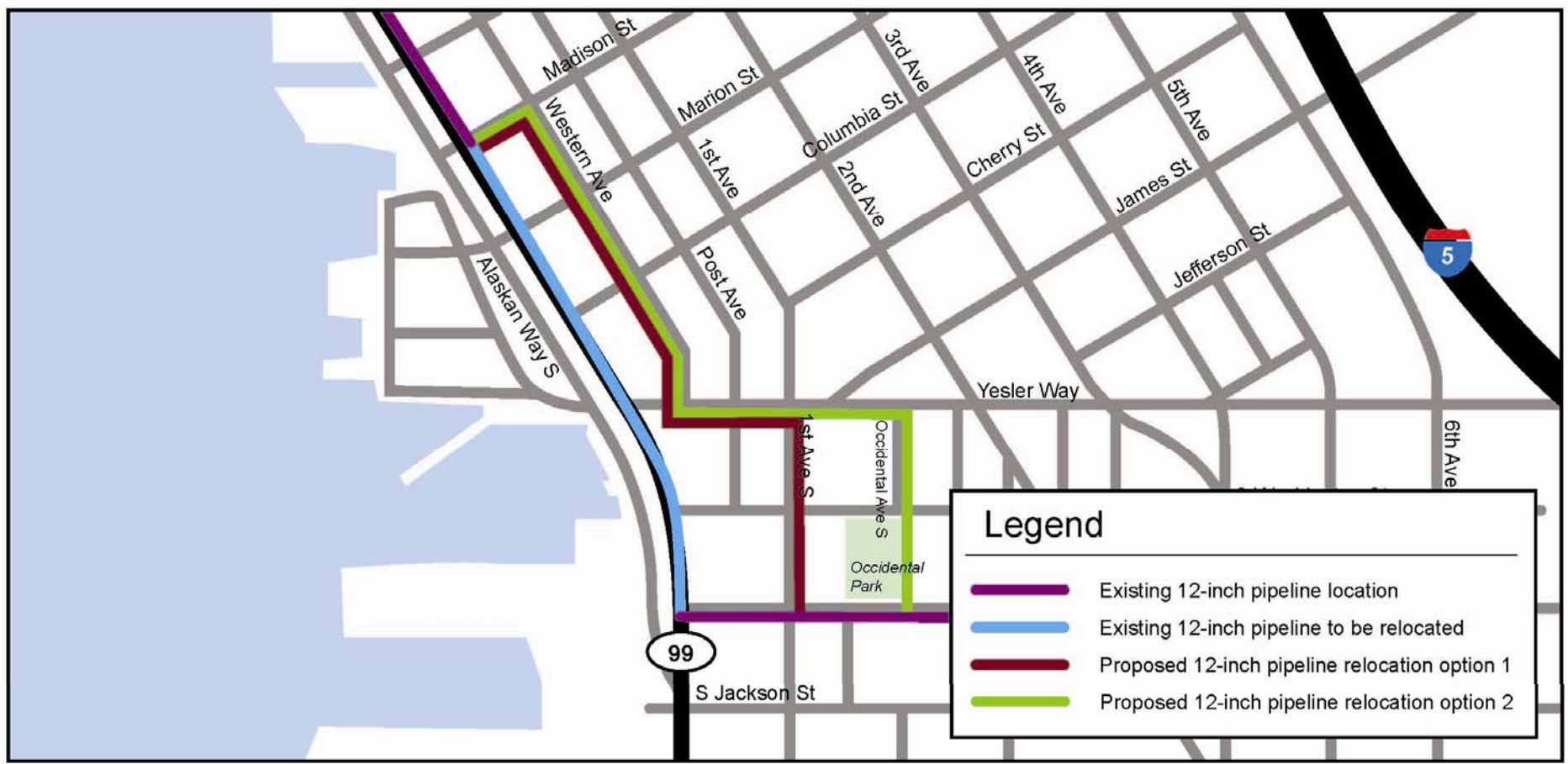

Alaskan Way Viaduct 12-inch High Pressure Natural Gas Main Relocation



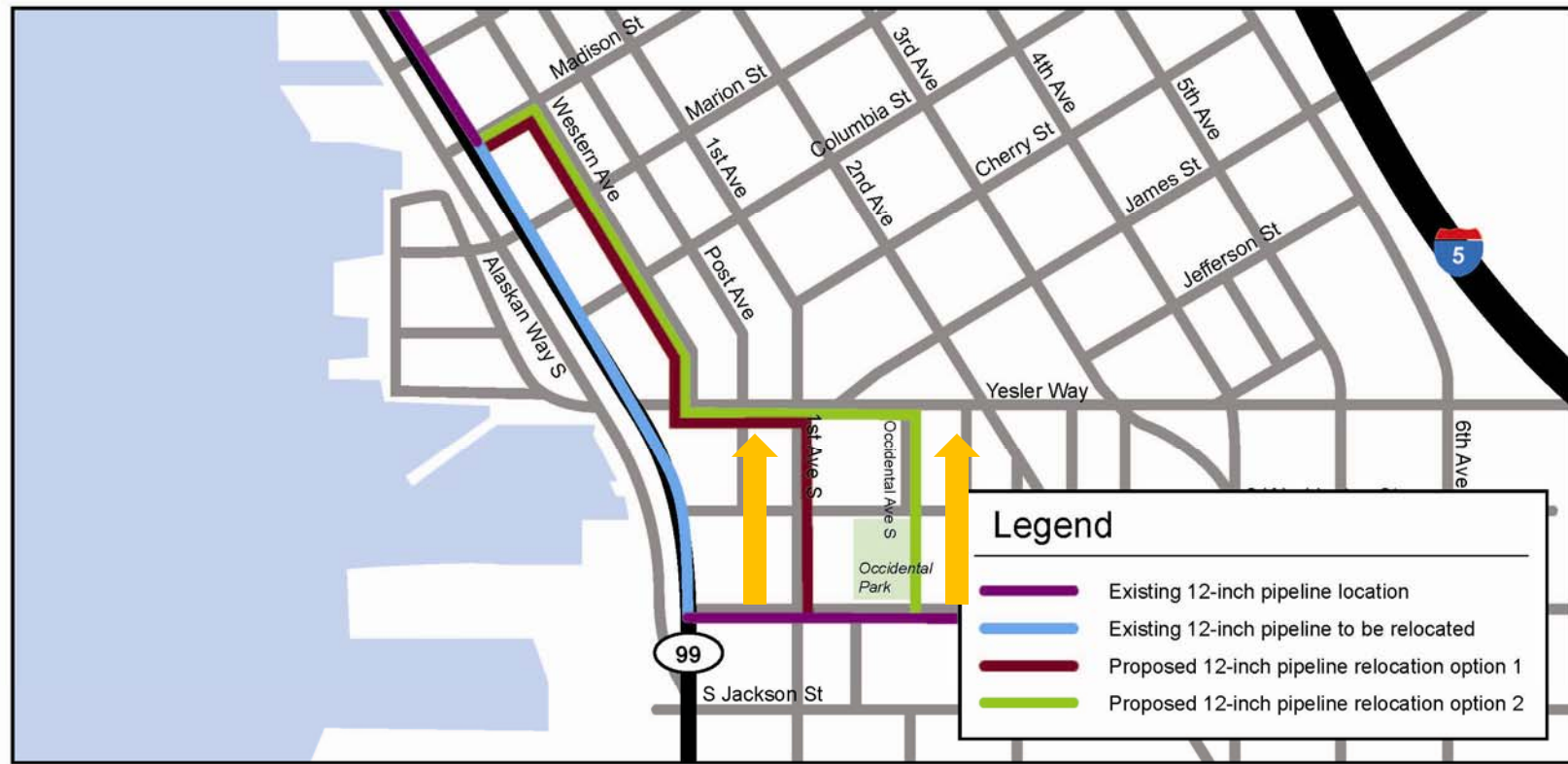
What we looked at:

- Moving the line to the east side of I-5
- Moving the line out onto Alaskan Way
- 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th Avenues
- Alleys
- Combinations of the above





What we looked at: Alleys



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Expected project schedule

- **Spring/summer 2012:** Community outreach
- **Summer/fall 2012:** Design and permitting
- **Fall 2012:** Start construction
- **Early 2013:** Complete construction

Construction would not occur during the summer and holiday construction moratoriums in Pioneer Square
