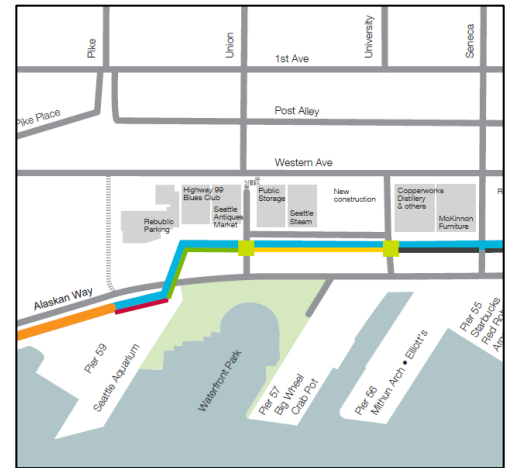
## Alaskan Way natural gas main relocation **PROJECT INFORMATION** ▶▶▶

Dear Neighbor,

This is a weekly newsletter to keep Waterfront and business stakeholders informed of this project to relocate the natural gas pipeline along Alaskan Way from Pike to Madison Streets. **InfraSource**, Puget Sound Energy's natural gas contractor is mobilizing and will begin work mid-week the week of November 9. The current schedule for the first four weeks (subject to change) is aligned with the project map below.

### What to expect

- Construction will take place along Alaskan Way South from Pike to Madison Streets with the first section beginning in front of the Aquarium.
- Work will take place mainly at night (6pm to 6am) Sundays through Fridays, though noisier work will take place during the allowed times of 6 to 10pm and 7 to 10am.
- PSE is working with affected businesses to ensure access and parking issues are addressed.
- Activities include saw-cutting, jack hammering, open trenching, and installation and testing of new pipe; restoration includes trench backfilling and roadway repaving.

### Traffic impacts

- Drivers can expect intermittent lane closures and parking restrictions; signs and flaggers will help direct drivers around the construction zone.
- Pedestrian and cyclist access will be rerouted around the work zone; signs and flaggers will help direct.
- Everyone must use caution when traveling in and around the construction zone.
