Pioneer Square natural gas construction look-ahead (Week of Oct. 21, 2013)

Below is a snapshot of upcoming construction activities as part of PSE's 12-inch high pressure natural gas pipeline relocation and soil settlement remediation projects related to WSDOT's Alaskan Way Viaduct replacement program (see project area map below):

12" natural gas main relocation project

• Oct. 22 and 23 - Crews will conduct grind and overlay on Western Ave. between Marion St. and Yesler Way. This will include grinding the existing pavement which will be noisy at times, we apologize for any inconvenience this may cause and appreciate your patience.

InfraSource soil settlement remediation activities *


- During the week of Oct. 21 AA Asphalting crews will be restoring portions of the sidewalk on Western Ave., north of Madison St. Work may include jackhammering, which will be noisy at times.

- Beginning Oct. 24 InfraSource crews will be replacing a natural gas main near the intersection of Madison St. and 1st Ave., and the work is expected to last approximately two weeks.
- During the week of Oct. 28 Crews will replace service equipment north of the intersection of Columbia St. and Western Ave.

What you can expect*

- Paving is expected to take place between the hours of 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. Mondays through Fridays and 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Saturdays
- Remediation activities are expected to take place between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. Mondays through Fridays, some weekend work may be necessary to complete work
- Work activities may entail the following, including: jackhammering, saw cutting, pavement grinding, open trenching, natural gas equipment removal and installation, trench back-filling, paving and work site restoration.

*Work hours, schedule and construction activities may vary based on location, permitting and weather events.
