
# Pioneer Square natural gas construction look-ahead (Week of Nov. 4, 2013)

Below is a snapshot of upcoming construction activities as part of PSE's 12-inch high pressure natural gas pipeline relocation and soil settlement remediation projects related to WSDOT's Alaskan Way Viaduct replacement program (see project area map below):

### 12" natural gas main relocation project

- Beginning as early as Nov. 6 AA Asphalt crews will be conducting restoration work on Yesler Way between
  Occidental and 1<sup>st</sup> Avenues. Parking on both sides of Yesler Way will be affected 7 a.m. 3 p.m. The work is
  expected to last through Friday, Nov. 8.
- Beginning as early as Nov. 7 AA Asphalt crews will be working at the intersection of Main St. and Occidental Ave. The work will continue through Friday, Nov. 8. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause and appreciate your patience.

### InfraSource soil settlement remediation activities \*





 Beginning as early as mid-Nov. - Crews will replace underground natural gas equipment near the intersection of Spring St. and 1<sup>st</sup> Ave.; Crews will install temporary equipment above ground while repairs are made to permanent underground system components, and the work is expected to last approximately two to three weeks.

# What you can expect\*

- Paving is expected to take place between the hours of 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. Mondays through Fridays and 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Saturdays
- Remediation activities are expected to take place between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. Mondays through Fridays, some weekend work may be necessary to complete work
- Work activities may entail the following, including: jackhammering, saw cutting, pavement grinding, open trenching, natural gas equipment removal and installation, trench back-filling, paving and work site restoration.

\*Work hours, schedule and construction activities may vary based on location, permitting and weather events.
