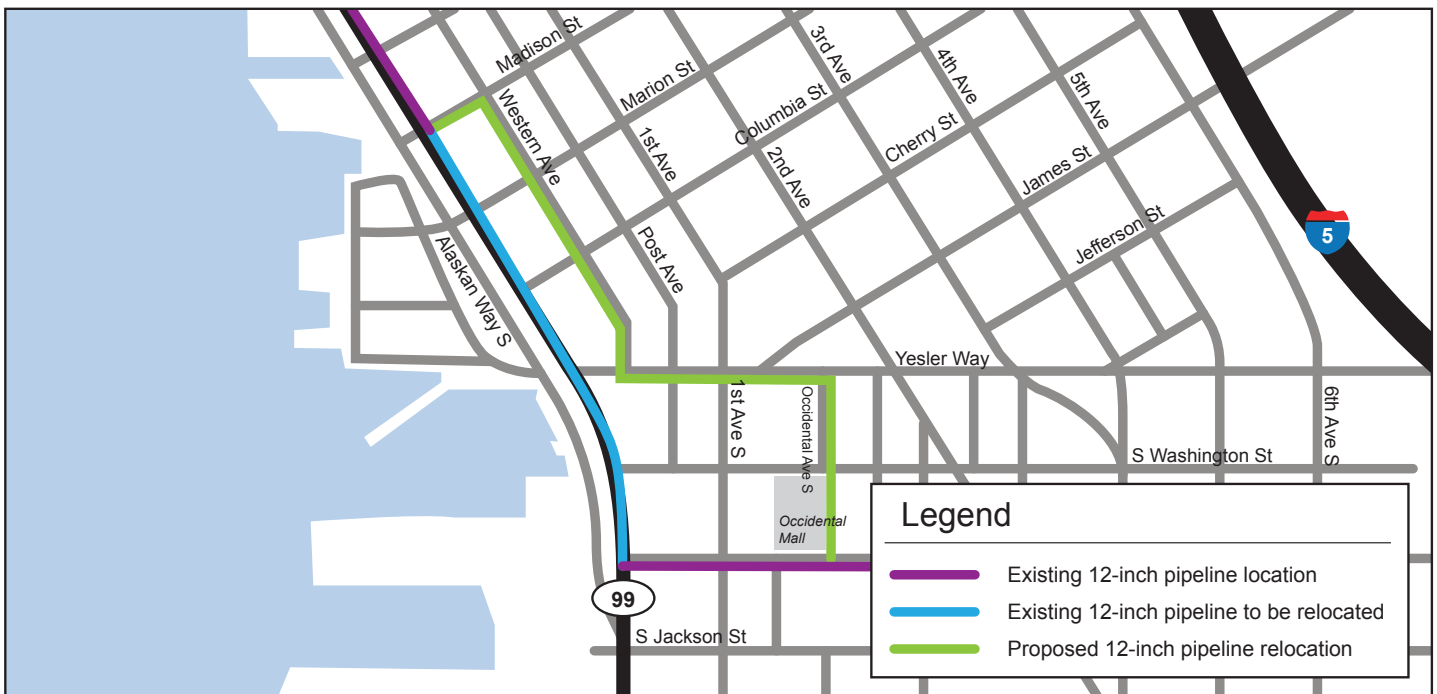


Update on PSE natural gas pipeline relocation project in Pioneer Square area

In conjunction with Washington State Department of Transportation's Alaskan Way Viaduct project, Puget Sound Energy needs to relocate approximately 2,500 feet of existing 12-inch high pressure natural gas pipeline in the core downtown Seattle area to ensure continued public safety and service reliability for PSE's Seattle-area natural gas customers (see map below).



The project team originally targeted a construction start date in January or February 2013, depending on permitting. The project is still in the permitting phase and we now expect to start construction in spring 2013. More details on timing and construction impacts will be shared as soon as we have additional information. We are working hard to come up with a construction plan that minimizes impacts to the community as much as possible.
