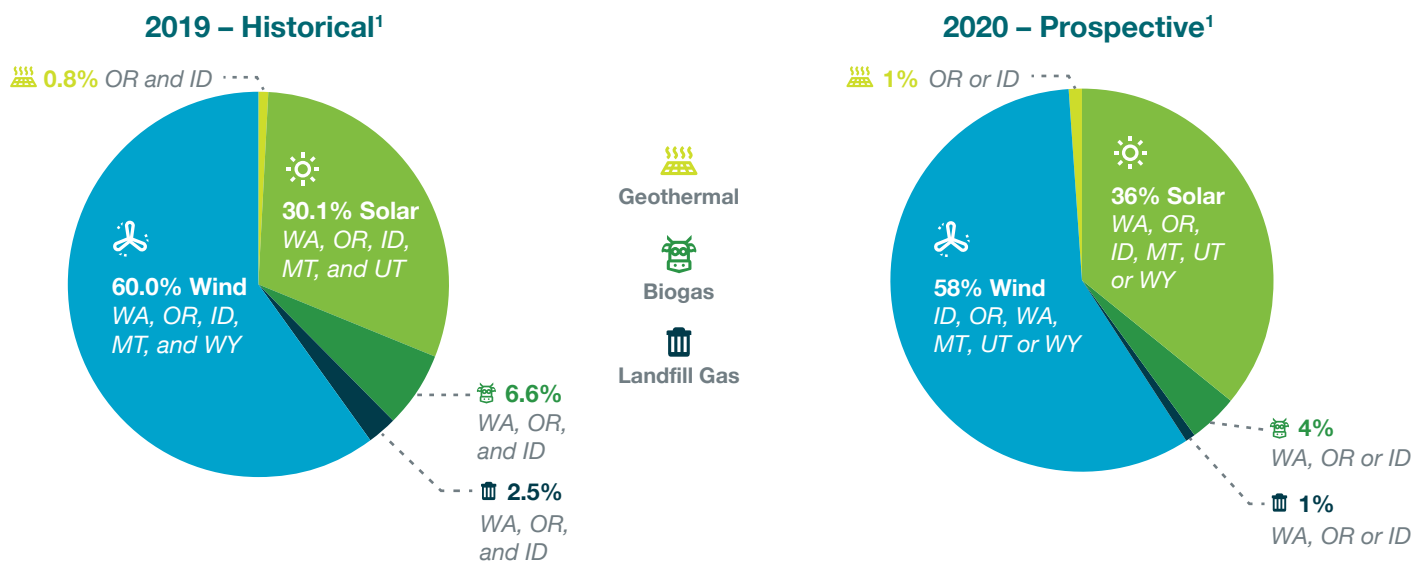


## PRODUCT CONTENT LABEL

Puget Sound Energy's Green Power Program is sold in blocks of 200 kilowatt-hours (kWh) or matches 100% of your electricity usage. These charts provide the renewable resource mix in the PSE Green Power Program in 2019, as well as the projected resource mix in 2020.

### Green-e® Energy Certified New<sup>2</sup> Renewables in the PSE Green Power Program



1. The Prospective figures reflect the renewables that we have contracted to provide. Actual figures may vary according to resource availability. We will annually report to you before August 1 of next year in the form of a Historic Product Content Label the actual resource mix of the electricity you purchased. Historic figures reflect the power delivered to the PSE Green Power Program's customers in 2019.

2. New Renewables come from generation facilities that first began commercial operation within the past 15 years. This product includes generation from a facility that is approved under a strict set of criteria as repowered.

For comparison, the current average mix of resources supplying PSE includes: Coal (36%), Hydroelectric (32%), Natural Gas (20%), Wind (10%), Nuclear (<1%), Other\* (<1%). \*Biomass, non-biogenic Petroleum.
