PSE's Natural Gas Tariff Filing - Filed Electronically

Dear Mr. Johnson:

Puget Sound Energy ("PSE") hereby submits proposed natural gas Supplemental Schedule 141Y Temporary Federal Income Tax Rate Credit. This filing, pursuant to RCW 80.28.060 and Chapter 480-80 WAC, proposes revisions to PSE's natural gas tariff.

WN U-2 - (Natural Gas Tariff):

Original Sheet No. 1141Y - Temporary Federal Income Tax Rate Credit - Temporary Federal Income Tax Rate Credit (Continued)

The purpose of this filing is to pass through to customers the tax amounts over-collected from January through April, 2018, subsequent to the Tax Cut and Jobs Act and the reduction in federal corporate income tax rates on January 1, 2018. New natural gas Supplemental Schedule 141Y Temporary Federal Income Tax Rate Credit proposes rate decreases for all customers for a period of one year, in accordance with the Commission's Order 05, Final Order Approving Settlement Agreement With Condition in Dockets UE-180899 and UG-180900 (Consolidated).

This proposal represents a \$10.5 million decrease in revenue or an average 1.22 percent decrease for all schedules. The typical residential customer using 64 therms per month would experience a decrease to their monthly bill of \$0.68.

The tariff sheets described herein reflect issue dates of March 29, 2019, and effective dates of May 1, 2019. As required by WAC 480-90-193, PSE will post the proposed tariff sheets on the PSE web site coincident with the date of this transmittal letter. Notice to the public of this rate decrease are not required under the provisions of WAC 480-90-194, however PSE will include this filing along with the rate impacts of all rate filings with proposed effective dates of May 1, 2019 in its public notice, within 30 days of the effective date.

PURPOSE: The Tax Cut and Jobs Act (the Act), signed into law by President Trump on December 22, 2017, reduced the federal corporate income tax rate from 35% to 21% effective for tax years beginning after December 31, 2017. This temporary schedule passes through to Customers the interim period tax amounts over-collected from January through April, 2018, in accordance with the Commission's Order 05, Final Order Approving Settlement Agreement with Condition in Dockets UE-180899 and UG-180900 (Consolidated).

TERMINATION: The rate credits under this schedule will terminate on April 30, 2020.

TRUE-UP: Any balance remaining, either positive or negative, as of February 28, 2021, will be included in the revenue requirement of the Schedule 140 Property Tax Tracker rate filing that will be filed in March 2021. The rate credits will not be available on adjusted bills after February 28, 2021.
