Request for Waiver of WAC 480-100-198**

Pursuant to RCW 80.28.060, WAC 480-80-101 and -105 please find enclosed for filing the following proposed revisions to the WN U-60, tariff for electric service of Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”):

The purpose of this filing is to submit a rate filing for electric Schedule 95A Federal Incentive Tracker. The filing results in an overall increase in electric bills for customers.

The prior year’s rate period represented the final year of the ten year period used to pass back the Treasury Grants included in Schedule 95A. The overall rate now represents a surcharge as amounts from last year’s filing are expected to be over-distributed. Following the January 2023 to December 2023 surcharge period, PSE will make no further rate filing and will transfer the actual residual balance to Schedule 120 in its February 2024 filing for final disposition.

This rate filing results in a total amount of \$1,038,316 to be collected from eligible customers over the twelve months, beginning January 1, 2023. Of the total amount, \$989,625 represents the over-

distribution of grant amortization and \$48,691 represents the associated interest from the 2022 rate period and estimated interest for the 2023 rate period.

This filing represents an overall average rate increase of 1.3 percent. However, there is no change to PSE's net revenue, as it is a pass-through of funds received in the form of a Treasury Grant. The typical residential customer on Schedule 7 using 800 kWh per month would experience an increase of \$1.16 per month or 1.3 percent. This filing affects customers on all rate schedules except those on non-core retail wheeling schedules.

The tariff sheets described herein reflect an issue date of October 31, 2022, and effective date of January 1, 2023. Posting of proposed tariff changes, as required by law and the Commission's rules and regulations, is being completed coincident with the date of this transmittal letter through web, telephone and mail access in accordance with WAC 480-100-193.

PSE will provide notice to customers in accordance with WAC 480-100-194(2) at least thirty days prior to the effective date. The date PSE expects to provide notice in compliance with WAC 480-100-194(2) is approximately December 1, 2022, so that the impacts of other rate changes proposed to become effective on January 1, 2023, can be included. Providing notice on December 1, 2022, will not allow PSE to provide the Commission a copy of the notice within ten days of making this filing as provided in WAC 480-100-198. Therefore PSE respectfully requests that it be granted a waiver of WAC 480-100-198 and be allowed to comply with WAC 480-100-198 within ten days of December 1, 2022.

**SCHEDULE 95A
FEDERAL INCENTIVE TRACKER**

APPLICABILITY:

1. This Federal Incentive Tracker rate shall be applicable to the electric energy delivered to Customers under any schedule contained in this tariff except those Customers served on Schedules 448, 449, 458 and 459 or Customers served under any special contract unless specifically included by such special contract.
2. Except those Treasury Grants passed through to Customers in accordance with the October 23, 2013 order in Dockets UE-130583, UE-130617, UE-131099, and UE-131230, and with the December 5, 2017 order in Docket UE-170033 (the "Final Orders"), the rates in this schedule shall include the sum of: (i) the Treasury Grants that the Company has received and that are eligible to be credited to Customers under Section 1603(d) of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 and applicable interest on the unamortized grant balance ("Grants"); and (ii) any tax benefits for manufacturing allowed under §199 of the Internal Revenue Code in the Schedule 95A rate year following the year that such tax benefits are utilized on a tax return ("Credits").
3. The rates in this schedule shall be adjusted annually to pass through the Credits and Grants for the Schedule 95A rate year adjusted by any true-up described in the Purpose section below.

PURPOSE:

1. To pass the benefits associated with specific energy generation through to Customers. This rate will be adjusted annually to include the Credits and Grants available to be passed through under this rate schedule to Customers for the rate year plus or minus any difference in the amount of Credits and Grants actually credited to Customers under this rate schedule during the current year when compared to the amount estimated to be passed through under this rate schedule. This adjustment will adjust the tracker due to actual load being different than the forecasted load used to set the rate. Finally, it will be adjusted for the difference between the estimated rate year Grant interest included in Schedule 95A rates and the actual Grant interest accrued during the rate year on Grants included in this rate schedule. This true-up may result in a Schedule 95A rate/charge being an increase to rates if no offsetting Credits or Grants are available. There will be no interest passed through under this rate schedule for the Grants governed by the Final Order. Following the January 2023 to December 2023 surcharge period there will be a residual amount either owed to or from Customers. The amount resulting on January 1, 2024 will be included in the electric Schedule 120 rates that become effective on May 1, 2024.
