**RE: Advice No. 2023-49
Puget Sound Energy’s Electric Tariff Revision**

Dear Executive Director Hunter:

Pursuant to RCW 80.28.060 and WAC 480-80-101 and -105, please find enclosed for filing the following proposed revisions to the WN U-60, tariff for electric service of Puget Sound Energy (“PSE” or the “Company”):

On March 23, 2023, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a letter into Dockets UE-220066, UG-220067, and UG-210918 (Consolidated) in which it accepted PSE’s revised tariff sheets establishing optional Time of Use (“TOU”) rate schedules to comply with Order 24/10, with a stated effective date of March 24, 2023. PSE began offering TOU rate Schedules 307, 317, and 327 to residential customers of the Company on October 1, 2023, and will begin offering TOU rate Schedule 324 to customers of the Company for general electric energy requirements other than residential service beginning January 1, 2024.

The purpose of this housekeeping filing is to add clarifying language incorporating the TOU rate schedules into electric Schedules 129, 129D, and 141TEP.

The tariff sheets described herein reflect an issue date of November 1, 2023, and effective date of December 1, 2023. Posting of proposed tariff changes, as required by law and the Commission’s

TRUE-UP: Each year, the Company estimates the amount of costs to be included in the Transportation Electrification Plan Adjustment Rider rates based on budgets for the implementation of the Company’s Transportation Electrification Plan approved by the Commission, as well as provides for a true-up of amounts from the prior rate period. Amounts to include in each year’s true-up are:

- a. A true-up equal to the actual operating expenses and depreciation and return on rate base paid or incurred minus the amounts set in rates for that rate period;
- b. A true-up will be included for the difference between what was expected to be collected when rates were set the previous year versus the amount actually collected that is due to variances in load; and
- c. As part of the annual filing, the Company will provide reports of the actual amounts for operating and maintenance expenses and rate base items that are included in the true-up calculation to allow for review by interested parties.

If a true-up calculation results in expenses/return being lower or actual revenues being higher than what was used to set rates, the amount will be a reduction to the amount to be otherwise collected under Schedule 141TEP during the current year. If a true-up calculation results in expenses/return being higher or actual revenues being lower than what was used to set rates, the resulting amount will be an addition to the amount to be otherwise collected under Schedule 141TEP during the current year.


