Dear Executive Director Killip:

Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”) hereby submits proposed revisions to its electric Schedule 139, Voluntary Long Term Renewable Energy Purchase Rider. This filing, pursuant to RCW 80.28.060 and Chapter 480-80 WAC, proposes revisions to the following electric tariff sheet.

The purpose of this filing is to revise the electric Schedule 139 Voluntary Long Term Renewable Energy Purchase Rider¹ Energy Charge Credit in accordance the Commission’s Final Order Appendix B -Settlement Stipulation and Agreement (Green Direct) in Dockets UE-220066 and UG-220067 (Consolidated) (“Settlement”), whereby,” Effective January 1, 2023, the Energy Charge Credit shall be \$47.826 per MWh and shall increase by two percent each year thereafter.” The Company included with its compliance filing revisions to the Energy Charge Credit for 2023 and 2024 in accordance with the Settlement. This filing proposes revised rates for the remaining years of 2025 through 2040.

The tariff sheet described herein reflects an issue date of November 22, 2024, and effective date of January 1, 2025. Posting of proposed tariff changes, as required by law and the Commission’s rules and regulations, is being completed through web, telephone and mail access in accordance with WAC 480-100-193.

7. **TERMINATION BY CUSTOMER:** Customers who choose to discontinue their service under this Schedule will be charged for the net cost of the remaining Renewable Energy that was to be delivered to the Customer under the remaining term of the Service Agreement. This amount will be based on: 1) the remaining term of the Service Agreement, 2) the amount of estimated annual Renewable Energy needs of each of the discontinued Customer' locations as listed in Section 5 of the Service Agreement, 3) the estimated output of the Resource, 4) the contracted energy rates agreed to in Section 7 of the Service Agreement, and 5) a credit for PSE's then-current avoided costs (filed consistent with WAC 480-107-055). Termination of service under this Schedule will follow receipt and processing of the termination request by the Company.
8. **MONTHLY RATES:** In addition to charges under the Customer's existing Electric Service schedule, Schedule 139 monthly rates include: 1) a credit for the energy-related power cost component of the Energy Charge of the Customer's Electric Service schedule, and 2) a charge for the Renewable Energy. Charges will commence with the Customer's normal billing cycle for that specific account(s) under which the Customer is already taking Electric service.


