**RE: Advice No. 2025-15
Puget Sound Energy’s Electric Tariff Revision**

Dear Executive Director Killip:

Pursuant to RCW 80.28.060, and WAC 480-80-101 and -105, please find enclosed for filing the following proposed revisions to the WN U-60, tariff for electric service of Puget Sound Energy (“PSE” or “the Company”):

WN U-2 - (Natural Gas Tariff):

4 th Revision	Sheet No. 135	Green Energy Option – Purchase Rider
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The purpose of this filing is to restrict the Solar-Only Green Energy Option under optional electric Schedule 135 to any new customers. The availability of Schedule 135 Green Energy Option – Purchase Rider is proposed to be limited to those existing customers being served under this schedule as of May 1, 2025. An existing customer will continue to receive service under the Solar-Only Green Energy Option under Schedule 135 until they choose to discontinue their optional service, after which time they will not be allowed to return to the Solar-Only Green Energy Option. The blended-renewable energy option will remain available to new customers.

Since PSE began offering the Solar-Only Green Energy Option ten years ago, the renewable energy market has changed, and PSE now offers other affordable and accessible alternatives to this service that customers can choose from. Although existing tariff schedule language permits PSE to limit customer participation to balance customer demand with available credits acquired from qualified alternative energy resources by the Company, this proposed revision provides additional clarity to customers about the reduced availability of service under this tariff schedule.

The tariff sheet described herein reflects an issue date of March 28, 2025, and an effective date of May 1, 2025. Posting of proposed tariff changes, as required by law and the Commission’s

rules and regulations, is being completed through web, telephone and mail access in accordance with WAC 480-100-193. Notice to the public regarding the restriction of access to service under Schedule 137 under the provisions of WAC 480-100-194, will be provided within 30 days of the May 1, 2025 effective date.

**SCHEDULE 135
GREEN ENERGY OPTION – PURCHASE RIDER**

AVAILABILITY:

1. Service under this schedule is available to all Customers as an option designed to provide Customers an opportunity to purchase qualified alternative energy resources. Service is on a continuing month to month basis unless terminated as provided herein.
2. Participating Customers will support the use and development of alternative energy resources or “green energy” resources which are generation facilities fueled by energy sources which include wind; solar energy; geothermal energy; landfill gas; wave or tidal action; gas produced during the treatment of wastewater; qualified hydropower; or biomass energy based on animal waste or solid organic fuels from wood, forest, or field residues or dedicated energy crops that do not include wood pieces that have been treated with chemical preservatives such as creosote, pentachlorophenol, or copper-chrome-arsenic.
3. Customers may participate in either the blended-renewable or the solar-only green energy options, or both.
4. Availability of service under the solar-only green energy option is limited to those Customers currently being served under this Schedule as of May 1, 2025. (C)

TYPE OF SERVICE:

Service under this schedule is provided through Renewable Energy Credits (“Credits”) obtained by the Company. These Credits will be provided through either: (a) Resources the Company owns or contracts for; or (b) the purchase of Credits issued by a clearinghouse or other system, provided the Company is able to secure verifiable evidence that there is a qualified alternative energy resource available and that the green energy attribute of the alternative energy resource will be available to the Company for purchase by its customers.

MONTHLY RATE:

1. Blended-Renewable Resource
Customers may purchase an unlimited number of blocks of blended-renewable green energy at \$2.00 each. A block is equivalent to a 200 kWh purchase. The minimum monthly purchase is two blocks per month. Under this option the monthly charge for blended-renewable green energy will be the same every month.
