The purpose of this filing is to implement changes to rates under the Property Tax Tracker mechanism, as provided in the Commission's Order 07 (Final Order Granting Petition) in Dockets UE-121697 and UG-121705 (consolidated) and the Commission's Order 07 (Final Order Authorizing Rates) in Dockets UE-130137 and UG-130138 (consolidated) (“Order 07”) and the Commission’s Final Order Settlement Stipulation and Agreement in Dockets UE-220066/UG-220067 and UG-210918 (consolidated). Electric Schedule 140 is filed annually to recover property tax costs in the current year and true up rates and property tax costs from the prior year.

This update represents an electric revenue impact decrease of \$1.4 million or 0.03 percent decrease in overall customer bills for Schedule 140. The typical residential customer on Schedule 7 using 800 kWh per month would experience a decrease of \$0.07 or 0.05 percent decrease. When utilizing actual revenues as stated in the Company's most recent Commission Basis Report, the decrease of \$1.4 million represents an average decrease of 0.04 percent.

Bill assistance programs such as PSE's Bill Discount Rate ("BDR"), PSE Home Energy Lifeline Program ("HELP"), the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program ("LIHEAP"), Past-due Bill Forgiveness (an Arrearage Management Plan which launched in October 2025), and the Salvation Army Warm Home Fund ("WHF") are available to qualified customers who need help with their energy bills. PSE customers can go to pse.com/assistance or call 1-888-225-5773 to learn if they are eligible. Payment plans are also available.

The tariff sheets described herein reflect an issue date of April 1, 2026, and an effective date of May 1, 2026. Posting of proposed tariff changes, as required by WAC 480-100-193, is being accomplished by posting the proposed tariff sheets on the PSE web site coincident with the date of this transmittal letter. Notice to the public under the provisions of WAC 480-100-194 will be provided within 30 days of the requested May 1, 2026, effective date.




